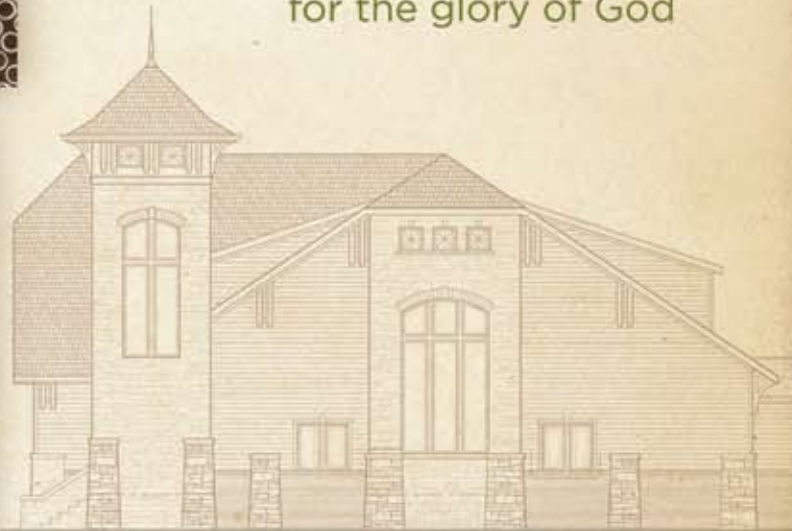

Dear Grace Family & Friends,

Thanks be to God who has kept us through fifteen years of ministry. For thirteen of those fifteen years, Grace Community Church was without land or a building to call our own. And yet, our identity as a church was strong and steadfast because of the power of the Gospel and our commitment “to continue in the things we have learned” in the Scriptures.

Four years ago, we were presented with the opportunity to purchase land and to build the building where you and I now worship. At that time, there were 300 people attending Grace. We had no idea what God would do through us. The Future Grace Giving Campaign was a 6-week process of praying, fasting, meeting together and studying the Word, which culminated in a Commitment Sunday to see what each person might give. The results were astounding: the initial offering and three-year pledges totaled \$1.2 million. Praise God for increasing our faith and providing the means for us to be established on this property for His glory.

It is our joy to see people stirred by the word of God and transformed by the power of the Holy Spirit. We are seeking to stay true to our mission: to build spiritually healthy people for ministry in the world. Every pursuit in this church is with the mindset that “all Scripture is inspired by God, and is profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for training in righteousness.” (II Timothy 3:16)

More people are coming to Grace Community Church. They are coming to be immersed in the word of God. Practically speaking, our classrooms are full. In order to make the best use of existing space, we created two Sunday School sessions, purchased a modular building for adult classes, renovated existing space, and reassigned classes to provide for major growth in our children’s ministry. During each worship service, every space that can accommodate a class is being utilized.

It is time for the second phase of the Future Grace Giving Campaign. The goal is to fund a new building for teaching and discipleship. The elders and I are leading our congregation in the process of discerning how each of us can give financially to this end. Our goal is to fully fund the new construction by giving \$2.5 million dollars through initial cash gifts and pledged money over a three-year period.

That may seem like a daunting challenge. The greater challenge is to faithfully pass on the word of God to future generations, that they will trust the Lord, remember His deeds, and keep His commandments (Psalm 78).

I pray that we rise to this biblical challenge and continue to love the Word of God, teaching and discipling with all diligence. Giving to this second phase of the Future Grace Giving Campaign is where God has us at this time. I am asking everyone at Grace to join us in this endeavor. Please read carefully through this brochure. Pray with us and fully participate in the events that are planned.

In eternity, it will be revealed how God impacted future generations in our city and the world through the faithfulness of our church.

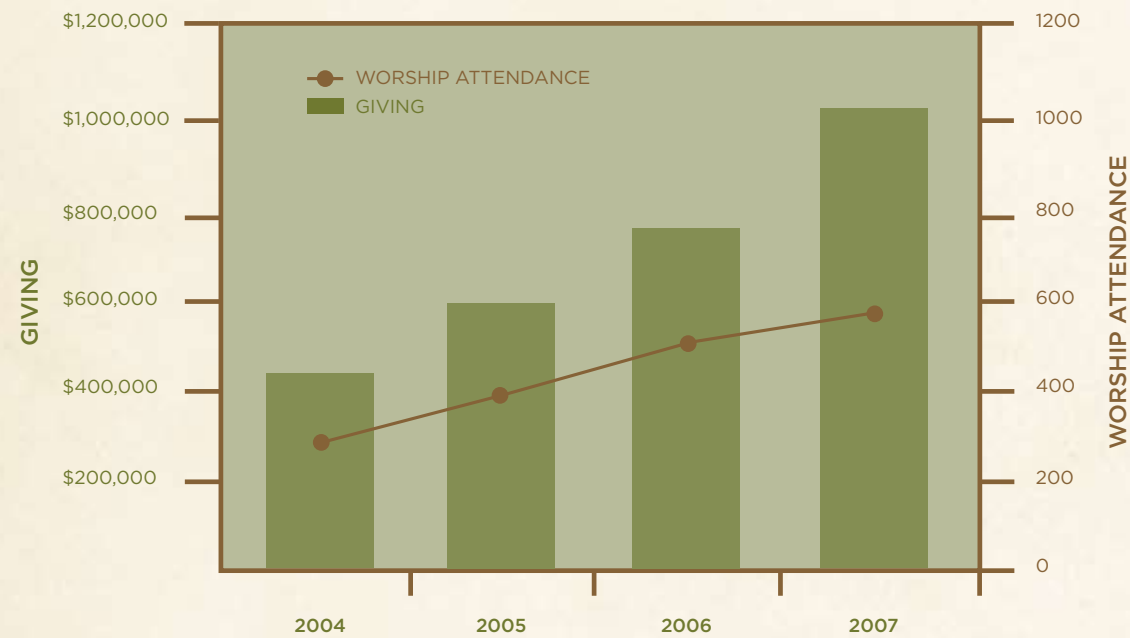


# Building for Discipleship

- The Future Grace Giving Campaign Phase One was a powerful example of what God can do through our faithful obedience.

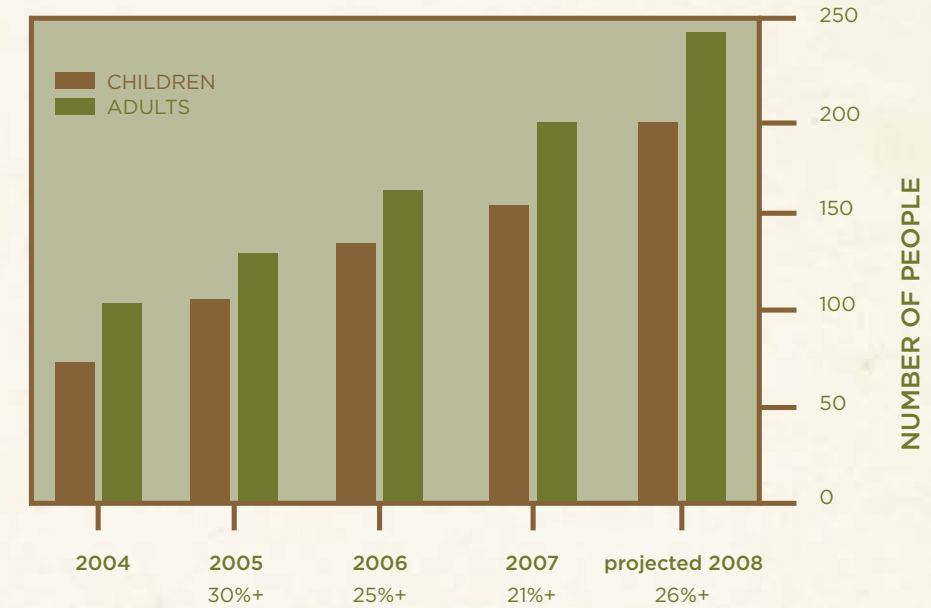
Worship Attendance and Growth



## Growth

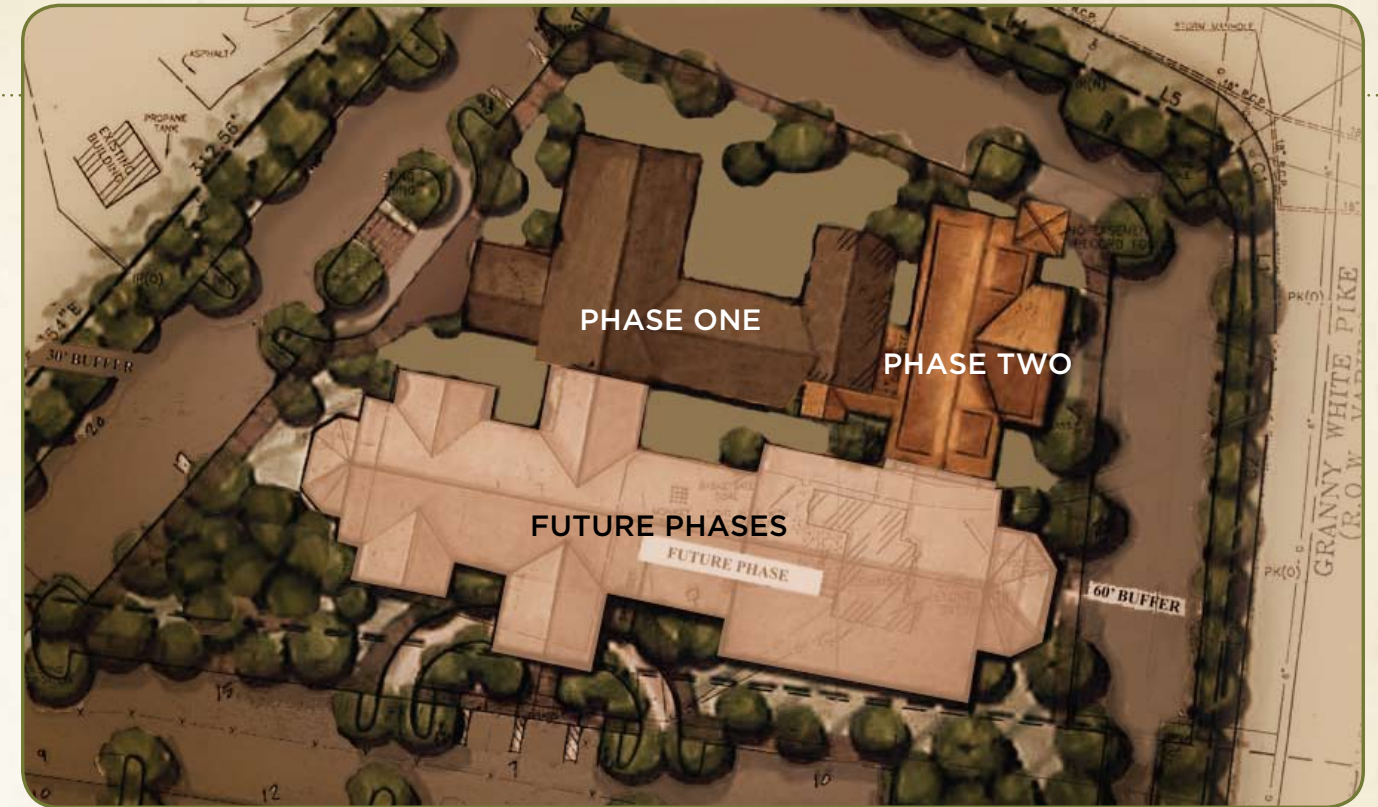
- The number of children and youth being disciplined in Sunday School has doubled in the last three years.
- Overall attendance of children and youth has grown 31% since August 2007.
- Many of our pre-school and grade school classes are at full room capacity with limited square footage.
- Grace established two Sunday School sessions in order to help manage classroom size and to provide better teacher to student ratios.
- Grace is utilizing all available space on campus to create classrooms for both Sunday School sessions.
- We are committed to providing ample space for teaching and discipleship for children, youth and adults.
- We are committed to moving forward with the Future Grace Giving Campaign Phase Two and to build.
- We are committed to fully fund this endeavor within the next three years.

# Giving Goal: \$2.5 million

The Master Plan (inset on the right) accounts for fully building out the property in phases, as the Lord directs. *Phase One* is the dark brown building which contains the current chapel, gathering hall, and classrooms. *Phase Two*, shown in light brown, is the discipleship building, depicted below, containing two floors of educational and multi-purpose space. *Future phases* are shown as indicated, and will be a larger worship center and additional educational space.



*Side elevation of future discipleship building as it will be seen from Old Hickory Boulevard.*



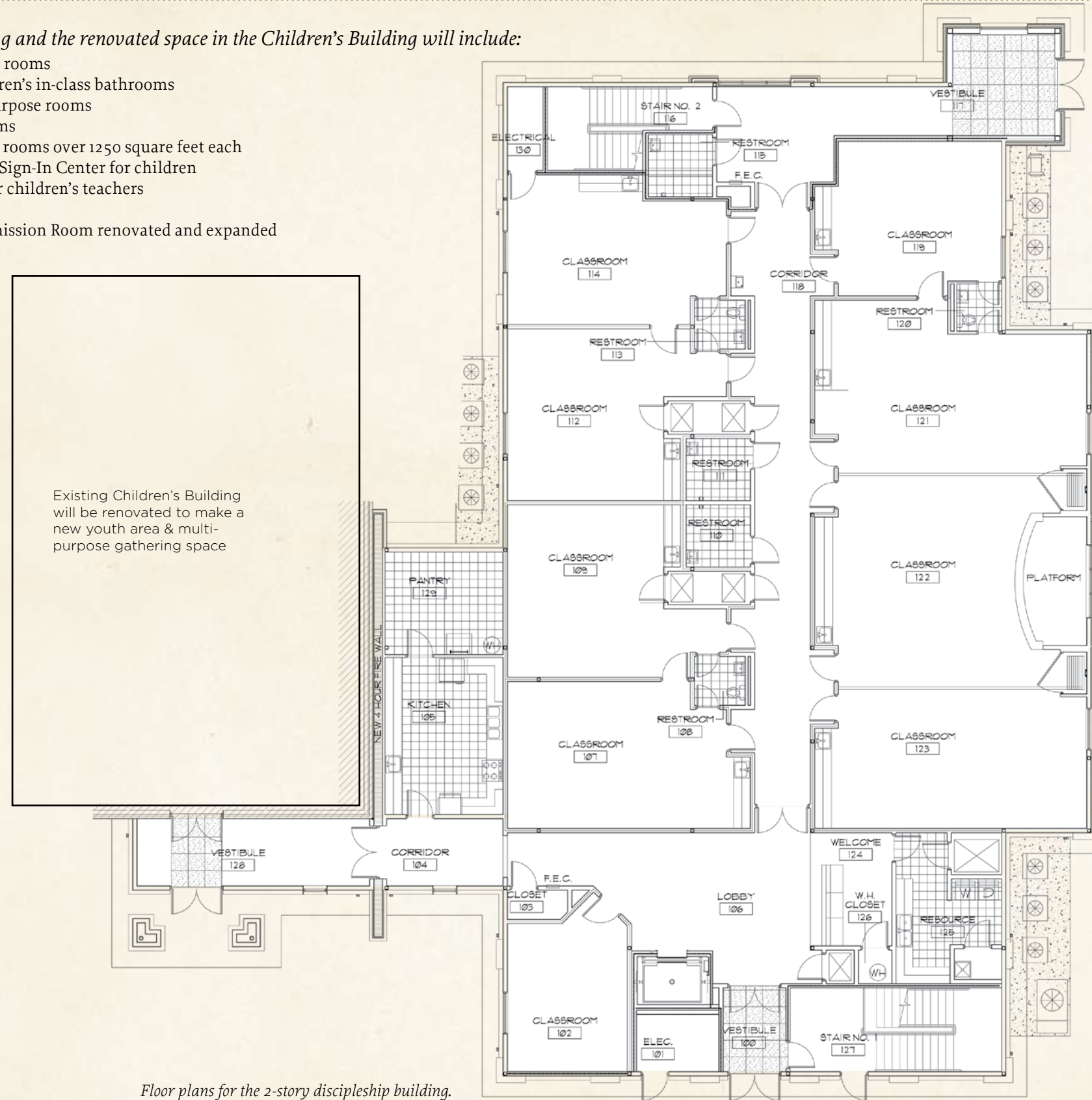
*The master plan, created when the property was purchased, indicates the location of existing Phase One, Phase Two, and possible future phases.*

The new building and the renovated space in the Children's Building will include:

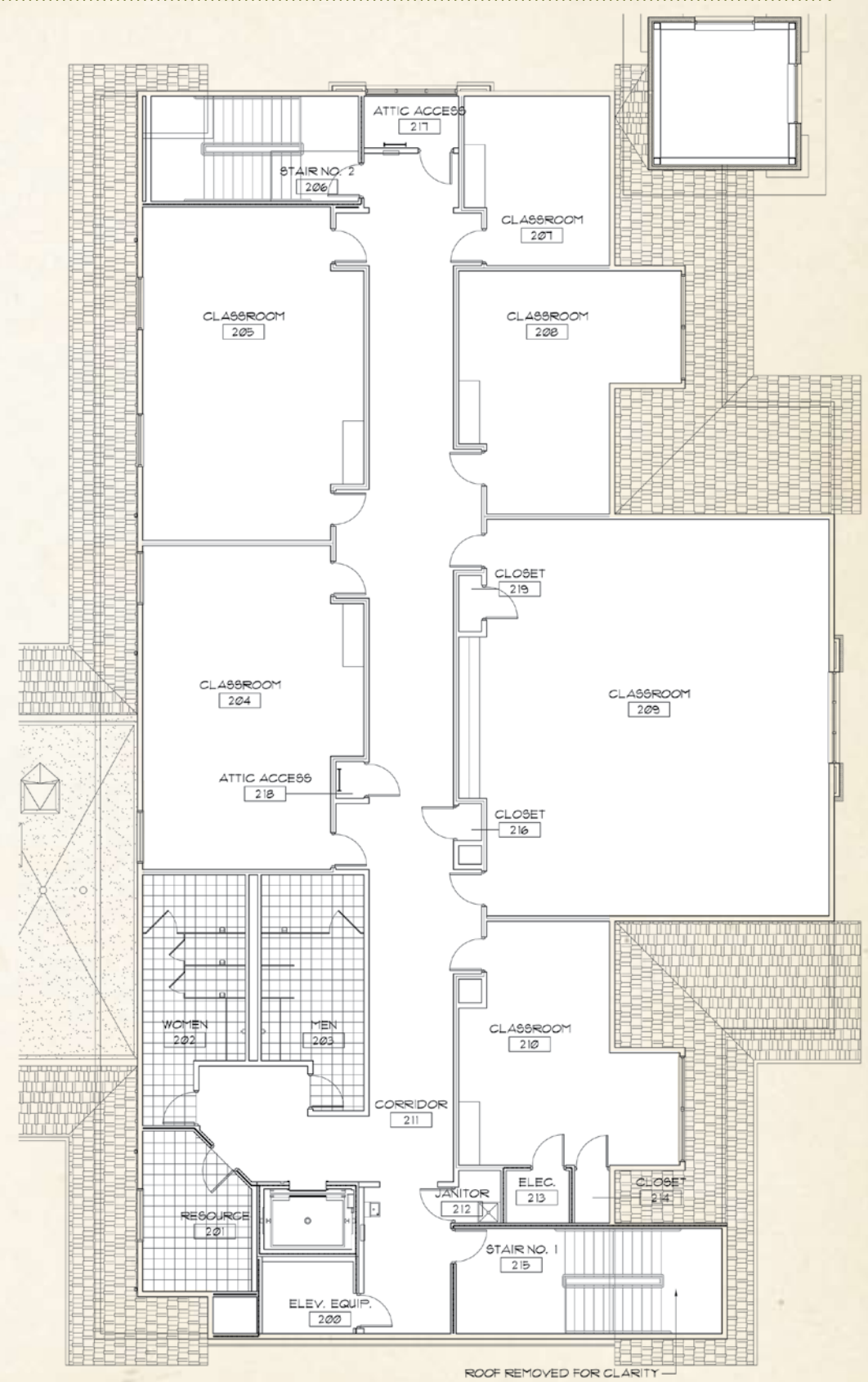
- 9 new children's rooms

- 4 adult bathrooms
- 3 multi-purpose rooms over 1250 square feet each
- an Information/Sign-In Center for children
- resource area for children's teachers
- small kitchen
- the Great Commission Room renovated and expanded

*And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect.*

*Romans 12:2 NASB*



## **Resources for Daily Renewal**

The Bible – meditate on the book of Mark, as Sunday sermons will be preached from this book throughout the Future Grace Giving Campaign.

28-Day Devotional Guide – *Walking with Jesus Through the Word*, included in the Future Grace packet.

## **Suggestions for discerning God's will for your Future Grace giving:**

- Pray every day, throughout the day. Pray that God will speak to us, individually and as a church, during this six-week spiritual process.
- Consider times of fasting (e.g., from food, television, computer, telephone) that would allow you to pray and reflect for a greater length of time.

## **As you fast and pray:**

- Purpose to give what you believe God wants you to give. Don't compare yourself to others. The principle to follow is "equal sacrifice, not equal gifts."
- Purpose to give what you believe God wants you to give. Keep yourself open to God leading you differently than you first expected.
- Ask the Lord to lead you to give in such a way that it builds your faith, deepens your sacrifice, and increases your joy.

- Keep a journal with you. Write down possible ways to increase income or decrease expenses and debt to allow you to give.

- Ask God what you are to give as a cash offering on Commitment Sunday, May 4.

- Ask God what you should pledge to give over the next three years. Future Grace pledges are to be what you intend to give in faith "over and above" your regular tithe. "In faith" means that you are committing to an amount of money that will require God's help to fulfill. You can give far more than you thought possible when it is spread out over time (see *My Giving Potential* chart on page 15).

- Ask God how you are to give of yourself through your church in 2008, committing to pray, serving in a particular ministry, and participating in outreach beyond the church to help make disciples and to advance God's kingdom.

- Commit yourself to trust God and to obey. He will give you the spiritual resolve to be diligent in saving and giving. Rejoice in your decision to give! Pray that God will increase our spiritual growth and that we will be poured out in service to our city and throughout the world.

# Q&A

**Q:** What is the Future Grace Campaign?

**A:** It is a six-week focus in prayer, study of the Word, worship and fellowship about the future of Grace. Our individual focus will be to discern God's will as to what monetary gift we can each give toward the building project ahead. Every person at Grace will be encouraged to give.

**Q:** How is the money being used?

**A:** We are giving money to provide for the teaching and discipleship ministry of Grace. All monies given and pledged will be used toward this purpose with any surplus used to reduce existing debt.

**Q:** Why do we need to build?

**A:** Our educational space is full and our classes are growing. The elders and congregation are in agreement that God is leading us to give now to provide the necessary space to teach and disciple those currently attending Grace as well as to provide for the future.

**Q:** Will the new building be large enough to meet the needs of our church?

**A:** We are building according to what allows us to remain good stewards in our giving and planning. Based on our current attendance and giving patterns as a church, this plan allows us to respond to growth needs without placing an undue burden on our church. If God allows our growth to exceed our expanded facilities, we will look for creative ways to provide for ministry within the space that we have been given and seek the Lord regarding future expansions.

**Q:** Are there future plans to build more?

**A:** Yes. This building is part of a master plan that was designed when we purchased this property. As need arises and as resources are available, we will seek the Lord regarding future phases of the master plan.

**Q:** How does our church view the issue of incurring debt?

**A:** The leadership of Grace believes that there are some types of debt that are acceptable. Just as most people believe mortgage debt is acceptable when it is incurred wisely and responsibly, so we believe that debt for land and buildings is acceptable when 1) there is a clear plan for debt repayment, 2) the value of the building exceeds the amount borrowed, and 3) the debt does not hinder our ability to do ministry by putting undue strain on our budget. In light of these principles, we believe debt is acceptable for this building project.

**Q:** Are buildings necessary to make disciples?

**A:** Our church's mission remains to build spiritually healthy people for ministry in the world. We believe that God uses physical resources and material means to advance His kingdom and to accomplish His purposes. We need physical space to gather for all ministries. Some form of building will always be used for ministry. We believe God has called us to provide that space.

**Q:** When will I have to decide what to give?

**A:** The week of April 28 – May 3 has been designated as Household Decision Meeting Week. It is during this week that everyone in our church is being encouraged to make his or her final decision as to what God is leading each one to give. On Sunday, May 4, the congregation of Grace will give in two ways: a cash offering and a three-year pledge commitment.

**Q:** Why am I being asked to give an initial cash offering and a 3-year pledge?

**A:** Both components are vital to Future Grace. The greater the cash offering, the smaller the amount we will need to borrow. Cash offerings given on May 4 will save the church interest and increase the monies available for the building.

The ongoing pledge enables you to give far more than is possible at one time. (See the *My Giving Potential* chart on page 15.)

**Q:** Can I give another cash offering later than May 4?

**A:** Yes. Any cash offering given after May 4 will go towards the construction loan.

**Q:** Can my tithe be designated to go towards this building project?

**A:** We encourage you to continue to give your tithe to the regular weekly offering at Grace while you give your pledge offering to the Future Grace Giving Campaign. This will enable Grace to continue to carry on ministry while we build the proposed building.

If you are not a regular giver to Grace, we encourage you to begin making adjustments to your lifestyle and budget to allow you to give on a regular basis to the church.

If you give regularly to Grace and doing so limits your ability to pledge to the Future Grace Giving Campaign, we thank you for your faithfulness in giving and encourage you to take joy in whatever you are able to pledge.

**Q:** I have never been involved in a decision-making process like this. How will I know what to do?

**A:** The Future Grace packet materials are a starting point for you to begin to consider how all this can be accomplished. The church as a whole will be in prayer throughout this season, asking God to expand our understanding and to guide our steps. A *Principles In Giving* seminar is being offered to any who desire further discussion and prayer.

Giving will help you grow spiritually as you depend upon God and exercise faith; it will deepen your commitment to God's purposes for Grace; and it will increase your joy in the Lord. Paul said in Philippians 4:17, "Not that I seek the gift itself, but I seek for the profit which increases to your account."

**Q:** Will my financial gifts be kept confidential?

**A:** A designated Campaign Finance Team will record your gifts. All gifts will be kept confidential within this Finance Team.

**Q:** As a parent, what are ways that I can involve my children?

**A:** The most important thing that you can do is let your children see how you are seeking God in the process of deciding how to give to Future Grace. Use prayer at mealtime and bedtime along with the Devotional Guide to help them see how God gives us all things through Christ. Encourage your children to give from their own resources as well.

**Q:** I only attend worship at Grace. Can I be involved in the Future Grace campaign?

**A:** One of the major goals of this giving campaign is to involve more people in the discipleship ministries of our church. We encourage you to take advantage of this season in our church to join a Community Group or Sunday School class for spiritual growth and fellowship.

**Q:** I want to give more than just my money. How can I become involved in the ministry of Grace?

**A:** There are various ministry opportunities available at Grace. You can pick up information at the Welcome Center or contact one of the staff in the church office for more details (377-8997). If you have not done so already, we encourage you to attend a New Members Class and be in covenant relationship with Grace.

**Q:** I am in a season of life that prevents me from making a significant financial contribution to Future Grace. What should I do?

**A:** The greatest contribution anyone makes to Grace is to faithfully live in covenant with the church. We encourage you to pray for and participate in the ministries of Grace and be at peace about whatever God leads you to give.

### Household Decision Meeting Checklist

Encourage them to draw a picture beforehand that relates to their family serving the Lord in a particular way. Open your Household Decision Meeting with a song that they are able to sing as well. Allow them to share their thoughts at the appropriate time.

Allow everyone to share how God has impacted them through this time (sermon series, community groups, Sunday School, prayer meetings, fellowship, devotional guide, quiet times).

Fill in the pledge card at the back of this brochure as to your decision for a cash offering and a three-year pledge. You do not have to share the amount of your gift with others.

Close your meeting with a hymn and a prayer (*In Christ Alone* is provided).

Celebrate! Rejoice in God’s goodness. Have dinner with friends, go for a nature walk, or plan ahead of time to go and serve someone in need.
